

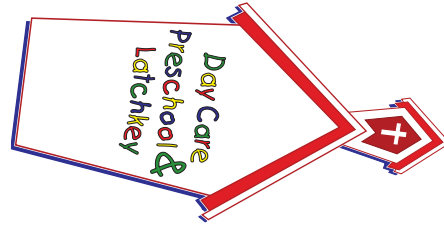

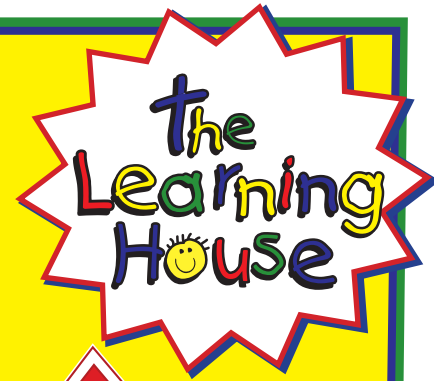

OUR PROGRAMS ARE DESIGNED TO MEET THE UNIQUE NEEDS OF YOUR CHILD IN THEIR AGE GROUP



INFANTS

We care for infants starting as young as six weeks of age. It is at this stage that your infant learns to trust.

The safe and loving environment of our infant room is a great place for your infant to discover, explore and learn. In addition to taking care of your infant's physical needs, our caregivers enhance development through stimulation from seeing, hearing and touching.

We also provide the cuddling and loving care that is one of the most important needs for every baby.



TODDLERS & TWOS

At this age, your child is active and ready to explore. He or she can begin to understand basic math concepts like sorting, matching and patterns.

Your child develops language skills, learns how to speak and expresses feelings. This language development will be critical to learning in all other areas including math, and is the basis for their future educational journey.

We also introduce the Spanish language as early as two years of age.



PRESCHOOL

In this age group, your child advances in expressing complex ideas and learns how to listen, comprehend and communicate. He or she is busy in a fun filled day of activities, learning and playing.

Our Spanish program is incorporated into our preschool curriculum and is offered as another form of language development.

Your child learns letter and number recognition, how to count, sort and how to use the computer.
